Accomplishments

by the deadline of November 15, 2023. This is a report of the stewardship of all three districts in the Georgia North Region.

Attended District Missionary meeting in two districts, anniversaries, Elberton-Gainesville District Conference held in Hartwell, Ga.

The GNR had (37) students who were recipients of the \$200 Helena B. Cobb Annual Grant Scholarship, checks were issued in September 2023. Atlanta-Rome (17), Augusta-Sparta (15), Elberton-Gainesville (5) students.

GNR had two students to compete and win the contest for the S.O.S-P.Ann Pegues Scholarship on the 6th Episcopal Level in the past (8) years. One student competed on the council level and received a \$2,000 yearly scholarship for (4) years.

GNR received the Golden Apple Award for contributing the most money in the last (4) years for the Helena B. Cobb and P.Ann Pegues-S.O.S. Scholarship, totaling \$34,761.46.

Thanks to the support of all (3) districts, who went over and above to increase our contributions to the Helena B Cobb Scholarship and S.O.S Scholarship Funds to over \$8,000, reported contributions to the council in 2023-24 totaling over \$11,000.00.

Challenges
